IMPORTANT NOTE

FOR ZOUZOUS CLASSES



Chers Parents,

Thank you for registering your child in one of our Zouzous classes (once or twice a week, 1.5 hour each time)! We will make sure she/he will enjoy a great experience with us, à la française...

And of course, your help is greatly appreciated! Here are few advices and information that will improve your child's learning experience at Alliance française de Singapour:

- **Regularity** is essential in any learning process, especially for the youngest ones. It is essential for them not to miss any classes (except for medical reasons).
- **Punctuality** is very important too: children arriving late can disrupt the whole class.
- Health and Hygiene: if your child is not feeling well, has fever, please do not bring her/him to class. If a teacher notices a child may have fever, she will do a temperature check. Children must wear non slippery socks or slippers within the class.
- **Stress**: if your child is in stress at her/his first lesson (lots of crying), do not leave the building immediately and stay close to the class.
- **Snack time**: please provide the following items:
 - wet wipes,
 - a bottle of water,
 - a small healthy snack like a fruit, cereals or a few organic biscuits.
- **Toilets**: please make sure your child goes to the bathroom BEFORE the class starts in order to avoid interruptions. If your child is still wearing pampers, please make sure she/he has a clean one when coming to class and a spare one in her/his bag.
- **Labels**: please make sure your child's bag, bottle, lunch box, and clothes are LABELLED with her/his name.
- French Immersion: classes are conducted in French only for a greater immersion. Every session, a specific theme is developed for a more efficient vocabulary enriching process. Each lesson is divided into different times (free playing time, greetings ritual, activities, snack time, activities, and goodbye ritual). Children are learning French through age appropriate activities including playing, singing and dancing, arts and crafts and story-telling. They are encouraged to interact in French with each other and participate actively for better results.
